**Group Questions**

1. **“Within a culture of honour we choose to celebrate who a person is without stumbling over who they are not.”**

Without naming names – think about someone who has stumbled and let you down recently. Now make a list of things about that person that are worthy of celebrating.

Remember the quote... “The heart of God is for every single person to be celebrated, valued, empowered, enabled, loved, cared for, honoured, recognised for who they are and what God is doing in them.” (Bill Johnson)

2. **“Dishonour occurs when we require every son or daughter to be the same.”**

This seems so obvious that it almost isn't worth saying! But we do all have a tendency to surround ourselves with people 'like' ourselves.
