Summary

This week we looked at how we can become believers who live out lives of courageous faith from the story of David and Goliath

Personal/Group Questions

Can you summarise the sermon and highlight anything you felt God specifically spoke to you about?

Nic defined courageous faith as ‘faith being outworked.’ He said it was the process of pulling heaven to earth through our prayers, actions, words and deeds! He then went on to speak about four lessons that we can learn from the story of David and Goliath:

Nic’s first point was that in order to have courageous faith we need to get our problems, difficulties and trials into the correct perspective.

Spend some time discussing in what areas you need to regain a correct perspective of God?

Nic’s second point was that we need to embrace God’s preparation.

What is God teaching you in the season that you are in?

Nic’s Third point was that we need to run at our problems rather than burring our heads in the sands. This could be in relation to finances, relationships, emotional health or even sin.

What are the mountains you need to run at in your life right now?

Nic’s final point was that we need to be better at sharing and celebrating God’s victories.

Finish the meeting by sharing some stories of what God has done. Celebrate together by worshipping and thanking Him for these answers to prayer.
